In 1936 Sergei Prokofiev was commissioned to compose an orchestral work that would introduce children to the instruments of a classical orchestra by linking a musical theme to each character in a story. Since the first performance in Moscow, one of Prokofiev's most celebrated works, "Peter and the Wolf" has delighted audiences of all ages.

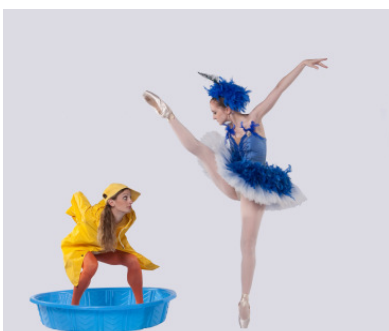
This ballet performance provides a great basis for discussion and follow up work in your classroom exploring the themes of obedience and courage. Reception to Year 3 would be the ideal age group to enjoy this performance.

As well as entertain, the aim of The South Australian Children's Ballet Company is to develop the creativity, imagination and self esteem of young people, through exciting dance performances.
